## Dear customer!

**The stamps in the *Research, Innovation and Technology* series** have attracted a lot of attention due to the QR code that links to the Research Council of Norway's website. The stories behind the different stamp themes are explained in more detail there. This turns the stamps into a source of knowledge. This year's themes are how Norwegian spruce trees can become animal feed and how Norwegian research was crucial for the development of COVID-19 tests. You can read more in Stamp Magazine, but I also recommend scanning the QR code on the stamps for the full story. As in previous years, Enzo Finger designed the stamps in this series.

**Stamps depicting the history of transportation** were first issued in 2017 and featured cars. Since then, stamps have been issued depicting bikes and mopeds/motorcycles, and this year's theme is ferries. Four routes/ferries are the motif on the stamps, including both Norway's shortest and longest ferry route.

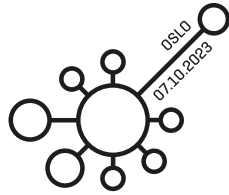

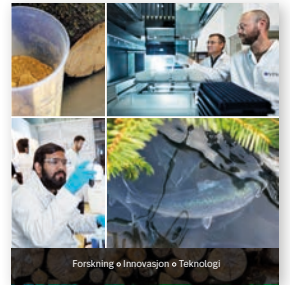

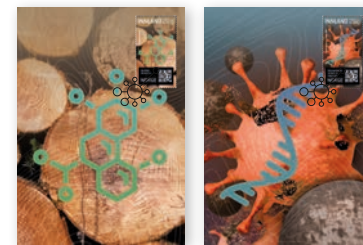
