The first stamp issue of the year was on 5 February. Two stamps marked that Bodø is European Capital of Culture this year. Bodø2024 is the largest cultural project in Norway in over ten years, and the largest in Northern Norway ever. Kristin Slotterøy has designed the stamps, which are issued both in booklets and in a beautiful miniature sheet.

Kongsberg celebrates its 400th anniversary in 2024. From being a mining town founded on the city's large silver deposits, Kongsberg is today the international small town with a spotlight on development, competence and cooperation. The city has some of the world's leading technology companies, which create future solutions for everything from the deepest ocean to outer space. Madeleine M. Karlstrøm has designed the stamp for the city's anniversary.

On 12 February it was 30 years since the Olympics in Lillehammer opened. Many still remember the wonderful Olympic days in February 1994, and not least there was a lot that happened with Norwegian stamps both before and during the Games. This was undoubtedly the best period for stamp collecting in Norway. We have made a commemorative envelope for the anniversary. Read more in the magazine.








The Best Olympic Winter Games ever



On 12 February, it is 30 years since the XVII Olympic Winter Games opened in Lillehammer.

With the opening in Lillehammer, Norway Post completed one of the biggest assignments for the Lillehammer Games. The torch relay from Morgedal to Lillehammer became a folk festival which, over the course of 75 days, visited both large and small places across the country.

But Norway Post's involvement in the Olympics in Lillehammer began as early as 1989, with the issue of the first of five miniature sheets with Norwegian Olympic winners. From 1992 to 1994, we issued 10 stamps for the Games in Lillehammer,

where the city of Lillehammer and the Festival of Nations were the motifs.

The envelope for the 30th anniversary is franked with the six stamps issued on 12 February 1994 and cancelled on the day 30 years after the opening. The cancellation, which shows Lillehammer's municipal coat of arms, is only allowed to be used on this envelope.


